## Come to the River







## Ride the Greenbrier River Bike Trail

The Greenbrier River Bike Trail, West Virginia's most successful rail conversion, offers 78 miles of scenic biking, hiking, horseback riding and cross country skiing and is a Rail-Trail Hall of Fame member since 2000. Outdoor Explorer Magazine describes the trail as "One of the finest rural trails in America, a 78-mile delight!" Blue Ridge Out-Door Magazine named the bike trail the Number One "rail trail" in the Southeastern United States. The rail-trail contains many of the elements that make the Mountain State one of Americas favorite retreats: the peaks and valleys, the lush forests, the pioneering history, the genuine hospitality of its small towns, and, of course, the Greenbrier River. Sometimes silent and lazy, in other seasons full and ambitious, the river is an almost constant companion to the trail and flavors the journey at every step. **Best of all, it's within a few FEET of your cabins back door! Wow!**

## Greenbrier River Attractions

Sightseeing is a must in Pocahontas County. Experience the Civil War at Droop Mountain State Park, West Virginia's oldest. Bear Town, West Virginia's most unique and Cass Scenic Railroad State Park where steam locomotives carry you back to an earlier period. On the Highland Scenic Highway, West Virginia's "Skyline Drive," enjoy spectacular views of Cranberry Glades and Williams River. At the falls of Hills Creek, you'll find three beautiful water falls from a boardwalk that's nearly a mile long, all the while surrounded by the Allegheny Mountains and the Monongahela National Forest, over a million acres noted for its rugged landscape with spectacular views. The head waters of eight rivers come to life in these mountains! Pocahontas County has more State Parks and Forest lands than any other West Virginia county. **Greenbrier River Cabin's are In the Heart of it all!**

## Explore Watoga State Park

Watoga State Park, West Virginia's largest, built by the CCC boys during the Great Depression, provides you with more than 10,000 acres of fun. It's just across the river from your cabin, so you can walk or bike there. Enjoy a multitude of recreational activities including 33 miles of maintained hiking trails, swimming, fishing and boating. There is something for everyone to enjoy at Watoga State Park.
